- (1) A person who is a child care staff member prior to January 1, 2018, shall submit to and complete background checks in accordance with this administrative regulation no later than September 30, 2018.
- (2) A child care staff member hired on or after April 1, 2018, shall:
- (a) Have completed the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation and been found to have no disqualifying offense prior to becoming a child care staff member; or
- (b)1. Have submitted to the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation;
- 2. Not be left unsupervised with a child in care pending the completion of the background checks in accordance with this administrative regulation: and
- 3. Be dismissed or relocated from the residence if the person is found to have a disqualifying background check result.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found a staff's (DOH: 03/01/2022) file did not contain documentation of background checks submitted through the Kentucky National Background Check Service. Based on review of the Kentucky National Background Check Service, the staff member did not have a completed background check; therefore, the staff person was hired prior to clearance for employment. The staff's file did not contain a completed Child Abuse/Neglect Background Check (CAN) or a Criminal Records Background Check (CRC). During interview, staff reported the staff has not submitted to fingerprints. Staff stated that the staff person has not worked alone with children. The surveyor did observe the staff person working in the Nursery with eight (8) children with a qualified staff person present in the classroom. Staff reported the staff person would complete their background check.

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor discover that staff's (DOH: 10/18/2021) file did not contain a high school diploma, GED, or Commonwealth Child Care Credential.

Staff reported he would have the staff person bring in their educational documentation.

405 - TB Verification Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. Staff's (DOH: 02/15/2022) file did not contain a copy of a statement from a health professional stating that the individual was free of active tuberculosis or a copy of a negative tuberculin result for the staff person; therefore, the surveyor was unable to verify if the staff person was free of active tuberculosis.
- 2. Staff's (DOH: 10/05/2018) file contained a negative tuberculin result dated for 01/19/2020; therefore, the tuberculin result was no longer current.
- 3. Staff's (DOH: 05/31/2019) file contained a negative tuberculin result dated for 05/31/2019; therefore, the tuberculin result was no longer current.

Staff reported he would have the staff update the TB skin test in their file.

- 2. The Two Year Old Classroom's lesson plan was dated 02/28 through 03/04; therefore, the lesson plan needs to be updated.
- 3. The Three Year Old Classroom's lesson plan was dated for 02/28 through 03/04; therefore, the lesson plan needs to be updated.
- 4. The One Year Old Classroom's lesson plan was dated for 02/28 through 03/04; therefore, the lesson plan needs to be updated.

Staff reported the lesson plans would be updated weekly.

- 3. Multiple holes that were small in diameter were located on a purple wall in the Three Year Old Classroom.

Staff reported he would have the floors cleaned and the wall repaired.

625 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. A ceiling tile located in the Preschool Classroom contained what appeared to be a brown water stain.
- 2. An air vent in the School Age Classroom contained a thick layer of dust.

Staff reported he would have the ceiling tile repaired and the air vent cleaned.

Staff reported he has been trying to get an immunization certificate for the child's file.

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that a child's (DOE: 03/11/2019) did not contain a preferred hospital or contact information for the preferred hospital.

Staff reported he would have the parent update the child's file.
