During a tour of the Infant Room, the surveyor observed a large, brown in color, water stain on two (2) ceiling tiles above the crib nearest the door. The director stated she had contacted maintenance several times to have the tiles replaced, but they had not done so.

General: Based on observation, it was determined this regulatory requirement was not met. During a tour of the PreK room, the surveyor arrived as the children were lining up to go outside to the playground. The surveyor entered the girls' bathroom and found the toilet still had urine and toilet paper in the bowl. The toilet had not been flushed and the class had gone out to the playground.
