General: Based on observation, the daily schedule for the Bellaire Graduates School Age room only had times and activities posted from 3:00pm-6:00pm. Staff person in charge stated that if school is closed for any reason the school age classroom would be open from 6:30am-close for that age group. There was no daily schedule posted showing what activities would be conducted from the time the facility opens to the 3:00pm timeframe.
