General: Based on observation, twelve chairs were stacked within the Panda's classroom and presented a tipping hazard.

- (a) Hired after January 1, 2009, who have supervisory power over a minor and are not enrolled in secondary education, shall have a:

- 2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. Two staff did not have proof of education on file. These staff were hired on 1/06/2022 and 2/14/2022

405 - TB Verification Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

- 1. A staff hired on 8/03/2021, did not have negative TB documentation on file.
- 2. A staff hired on 8/23/2021, did not have negative TB documentation on file.
- 3. A staff hired on 8/24/2021, had a TB skin test on file that was no longer current. The TB skin test was dated 11/09/2019, and is valid for two years.
- 4. A substitute staff hired on 7/12/2021, had a TB skin test on file that was no longer current. The TB skin test was dated 2/20/2019, and is valid for two years.
- 5. A staff hired on 2/17/2020, had a TB skin test on file that was no longer current. The TB skin test was dated 1/09/2020, and is valid for two years.
- 6.A staff hired on 1/20/2020, had a TB skin test on file that was no longer current. The TB skin test was dated 1/15/2020, and is valid for two years.
- 7. A staff hired on 7/24/2017, had a TB skin test on file that was no longer current. The TB skin test was dated 8/21/2019, and is valid for two years.
- 8. A staff hired on 3/15/2021, had a TB skin test on file that was no longer current. The TB skin test was dated 3/06/2020, and is valid for two years.

435 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
- (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

- 1.A staff member hired on 7/27/2020, completed PAHT training on 6/29/2015; however, did not renew the training due 6/29/2020.
- 2. A staff member hired on 9/26/2013, completed ten of the fifteen early care and education training hours between 7/01/2020 and 6/30/2021.

The ECE-TRIS system was reviewed and confirmed these findings.

- (6) Medication, including refrigerated medication, shall be:
- (a) Stored in a separate and locked place, out of the reach of a child unless the medication is:
- 1. A first aid supply and is maintained in accordance with subsection (1) of this section;
- 2. Diaper cream, sunscreen, or toothpaste. Diaper cream, sunscreen, or toothpaste shall be inaccessible to a child;
- 3. An epinephrine auto-injector. A licensed child-care center shall comply with KRS 199.8951 and 311.646, including:
- a. An epinephrine auto-injector shall be inaccessible to a child;
- b. A child-care center shall have at least one (1) person onsite who has received training on the administration of an epinephrine auto-injector if the child-care center maintains an epinephrine auto-injector;
 - c. A child-care center shall seek emergency medical care for a child if an auto-injector is administered to the child; and
- d. A child-care center shall report to the child's parent and the cabinet in accordance with 922 KAR 2:090, Section 13(1)(b) if an epinephrine auto-injector is administered to a child; or
- 4. An emergency or rescue medication for a child in care, such as medication to respond to diabetic or asthmatic condition, as prescribed by the child's physician. Emergency or rescue medication shall be inaccessible to a child in care;
- (b) Kept in the original bottle; and
- (c) Properly labeled.
- (7) Medication shall not be given to a child if the medication's expiration date has passed.
