Upon request, the staff member in charge did not provide verification that an annual written performance review had been conducted for staff members with hire dates of 10/04/09, 08/18/14, 09/08/14, 07/18/16, and 09/16/16

350 - Health, Safety, Comfort **Not In Compliance**

- (1) A director shall:
- (I) Assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child;

### Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center director failed to assure compliance with regulatory requirements. Observation of the bathroom in the two (2) year old classroom revealed a toilet brush was next to the toilet, and accessible to the children in care.

### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Upon request, the staff member in charge did not present verification that the file for a staff member with a hire date of 10/04/09 contained a current statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or a copy of negative tuberculin results.

410 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain documentation in accordance with regulatory requirements. Upon request, the staff member in charge did not present verification that the staff members with hire dates of 08/09/09, 09/08/14 and 07/18/16 had completed one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training within the past five (5) years.

- (3) Rest time shall include adequate space specified by the child's age as follows:
- (a) For an infant:
- 3. No loose bedding, such as a bumper or a blanket; and
- 4. No toys or other items except the infant's pacifier;

### Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to comply with regulatory programming requirements. Observation of the infant room revealed an infant sleeping on top of a loose blanket, which was bunched up under his face.

- (7) The following shall be inaccessible to a child in care:
- (a) Toxic cleaning supplies, poisons, and insecticides;
- (b) Matches, cigarettes, lighters, and flammable liquids; and
- (c) Personal belongings and medications of staff.

### Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation of the preschool classroom revealed a staff member's cell phone was on top of a low cubby shelf, and accessible to the children in care.
