General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the child care center failed to comply with regulatory requirements. A report of suspected abuse was made to the child care center and DRCC by a parent. The parent reported that her child had received scratches and bruising to the arm, which occurred while in care of the child care center. A report was not made by the child care center to the cabinet after discovery of an allegation of child abuse within the required timeframe.

General: Based on interview, the child care center director failed to assure compliance with regulatory requirements regarding the health, safety and comfort of a child. While in the care of the child care center staff, a child received bruising and scratches to his left arm. The injuries were a result of a staff member forcefully grabbing the child inappropriately.
