Findings:	
<p>General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the child care center failed to comply with regulatory requirements. A report of suspected abuse was made to the child care center and DRCC by a parent. The parent reported that her child had received scratches and bruising to the arm, which occurred while in care of the child care center. A report was not made by the child care center to the cabinet after discovery of an allegation of child abuse within the required timeframe.</p>

Findings:	
<p>General: Based on interview, the child care center director failed to assure compliance with regulatory requirements regarding the health, safety and comfort of a child. While in the care of the child care center staff, a child received bruising and scratches to his left arm. The injuries were a result of a staff member forcefully grabbing the child inappropriately.</p>

922 KAR 2:120. Section 2. Child Care Services.

(10) A child shall not be subjected to:

- (a) Corporal physical discipline pursuant to KRS 199.896(18);**
- (b) Loud, profane, threatening, frightening, humiliating, or abusive language; or**
- (c) Discipline that is associated with:**
 - 1. Rest;**
 - 2. Toileting; or**
 - 3. Food.**

Findings:

General: Based on interview, the child care center failed to comply with programming requirements. A four-year-old child was forcefully placed in a corner on the floor after being grabbed by the arm. Therefore, inappropriate discipline procedures were used.
