General: Upon request, the staff in charge did not present verification that more than one (1) staff meeting had been conducted and documented in writing within the last year.

General: Upon request, the staff in charge did not present verification of the evaluations assessing the staff person's interaction with children in care and classroom performance for the employees with the hire dates of 09/08/2014, 08/18/2014 and 08/23/2017.

Findings:

General: Upon request, the staff in charge did not provide verification that the employee with the hire date of 02/13/2020 had a personnel file to include: name, address, date of birth, and date of employment, proof of educational qualifications or copy of a statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis, or a copy of negative tuberculin results.

390 - Educational Requirements Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (a) Hired after January 1, 2009, who have supervisory power over a minor and are not enrolled in secondary education, shall have a:

General: Upon request, the staff in charge did not present verification that the records of the employees with the hire dates of 08/13/2017, 05/31/2019 and 02/13/2020 contained a copy of a High school diploma: or a GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity, or Commonwealth Child Care Credential.

395 - TB Verification Not In Compliance

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

General: Upon request, the staff in charge did not present verification that the records of the employees with the hire dates of 08/23/2017 and 02/13/2020 contained a current copy of a statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis, or a copy of negative tuberculin results.

405 - Adequate Substitute(s)

- (6) Child-care centers shall have available in case of need:
- (a) One (1) qualified substitute staff person for a Type II child-care center; or
- (b) Two (2) qualified substitute staff persons for a Type I child-care center.

- (a) Meet the staff requirements of this administrative regulation; and
- (b) Provide the required documentation to verify compliance with this administrative regulation.

General: Upon request, staff in charge did not provide verification that the child care center had employed at least two (2) qualified substitute staff persons. The staff in charge presented one (1) substitute for review.

410 - Training Not In Compliance

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Upon request, the staff in charge did not present verification that the employees with the hire dates of 10/04/2009, 08/09/2009, 09/08/2014 and 08/23/2017 had not met the requirement of Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment. The staff with the hire date of 08/09/2009 had not met the requirement of updating pediatric head trauma training. Review of documentation in the ECE-TRIS training system revealed the staff members listed above had not met the requirements.

General: Upon request, the staff in charge did not present verification that a menu had been completed and posted in a conspicuous place for review.

- (a) A current immunization certificate for each child in care within thirty (30) days of the child's enrollment, unless an attending physician or the child's parent objects to the immunization of the child pursuant to KRS 214.036;

Findings:

General: Upon request, the staff in charge did not present verification that the record for the child enrolled on 01/09/2018 contained a current Kentucky immunization record. The record presented was for the state of Indiana.

1140 - Enrollment Information Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 9. Records.

- (1) A child-care center shall maintain:
- (b) A written record for each child:
- 1. Completed and signed by the child's parent;
- 2. Retained on file on the first day the child attends the child-care center; and
- 3. To contain:
- a. Identifying information about the child, which includes, at a minimum, the child's name, address, and date of birth;
- b. Contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's:
- (i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;
- (ii) Family physician; and
- (iii) Preferred hospital;
- c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;
- d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:
- (i) Allergies;
- (ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and
- (iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center;
- e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency involving or impacting the child;
- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

Findings:

General: Upon request, the staff in charge did not present verification that the record for the child with an enrollment date of 12/17/2018 contained information listing a name of a preferred hospital. Continued review revealed the child with the enrollment date of 12/05/2019 listed a name of a physician, preferred hospital, medical information and emergency authorization.

(1) A licensed child-care center shall have a written evacuation plan in the event of a fire, natural disaster, or other threatening situation that may pose a health or safety hazard for a child in care in accordance with KRS 199.895 and 42 U.S.C. 9858c(c)(2)(U).

Findings

General: Upon request, the staff in charge did not present verification that the evacuation plan in the event of a fire, natural disaster, or other threatening situation that may pose a health or safety hazard for a child in care had been submitted to the local emergency management team within the last year. The record presented did not list the current address or child care center.

1195 - Fire Drills Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 3. General Requirements.

- (12) A fire drill shall be:
- (a) Conducted during hours of operation at least monthly; and
- (b) Documented
- (13) An earthquake drill and a tornado drill shall be:
- (a) Conducted during hours of operation at least quarterly; and
- (b) Documented.

Findings:

General: Upon request, the staff in charge did not provide verification that the fire drill had been conducted for the months of November and December of 2109 and January and February of 2020.

- (e) A description of services provided by the child-care center, including: $\frac{1}{2}$
- 1. Current rates for child care; and
- 2. Each service charged separately and in addition to the basic rate for child care;
- (f) Minimum staff-to-child ratios and group size established in 922 KAR 2:120; and
- (g) Daily planned program.

Findings:

General: Upon request, the staff in charge did not present verification that each statement of deficiency issued by the cabinet during the current licensure year and each plan of correction submitted by the child-care center to the cabinet during the current licensure year was readily accessible for public inspection.
