- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulations. Review of staff files and the Early Care and Education Training Records Information System (ECE-TRIS) report revealed documentation of fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training was not presented for review at the time of survey for one (1) staff member with the hire date of 1/4/17. In addition, the director acknowledged that documentation for the above-mentioned staff member was not on file at the time of survey.
