- 3. There was a crack on the yellow structure on the big kid's playground. Therefore, the structure was not in good repair.
- 4. The steering wheel was broken off of a black and gray Little Tikes car.

During interview, staff stated that she would have all broken toys removed from the playground and have the yellow structure repaired.
