#### Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the child care center failed to comply with staffing requirements. Observation of the gym on 12/17/19 revealed one staff member was the the sole caregiver of sixteen (16) three (3) and four (4) year old children. A second staff member entered the gym approximately two (2) minutes later, and stated that she had left the room for about five (5) minutes to use the restroom.

## **Director Requirements**

350 - Health, Safety, Comfort Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 10. Director Requirements and Responsibilities.

- (1) A director shall:
- (I) Assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child;

#### Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the child care center director failed to ensure compliance with regulatory requirements. Interview with staff members and review of written statements from staff members revealed a staff member displayed aggressive behavior toward the children in her care. The staff member was observed by two (2) other staff members on more than one occassion to hit children on the bottom with an open hand. On another oscassion, the staff member was observed to hit a child with an open hand on the top of the head. The staff member was also observed by another staff member to move children by pulling their upper arms. Several interviews revealed that the aforementioned staff member frequently yelled or used too loud of a voice when caring for children.
