General: Based on observation, the blue wall in the infant/crawlers classroom had a large area under the window where the paint had chipped and was pulling from the wall.

650 - Toilet Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (4) Each toilet shall:
- (a) Be kept in clean condition;
- (b) Be kept in good repair;
- (c) Be in a lighted room; and

Findings:

General: Observation of the boys and girls bathroom revealed there were broken/damaged tile around the floor drain. The drain is located in front of the sinks. Additionally, the ventilation system in the restroom located in classroom B-10 did not appear to be operational.

General: Based on observation, there was no protective surface material around the swings and slide on the playground. There was dirt and grass showing. The toddler playground had a slide with no protective surface. The surface under the slide was concrete.

General: Based on observation, in the infant classroom there were eight-(8) crib mattress sheets that had excessive material; therefore, the sheets were not tight fitted.

(6) Cots, equipment, and furnishings used for sleeping and napping shall be spaced twelve (12) inches apart to allow free and safe movement by a person.

Findings:

General: Based on observation in the infant classroom, there were two (2) infants sleeping in cribs next to each other. The cribs were not spaced twelve (12) inches apart to allow movement around the crib.

820 - Indoor/Outdoor Equipment

- (2) Indoor and outdoor equipment shall:
- (a) Be clean, safe, and in good repair;

The thermometer was reading sixty (60) degrees Fahrenheit.
