Findings:

General: Based on Observation and interview, there were eight (8) infants present on 11/5/18. The infants' room had six (6) cribs; therefore, two (2) infants were not provided with an individual crib for restime. Interview determined there were ten (10) infants enrolled and there were eight (8) infants present each day.
