750 - Playground Conditions Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

- (20) An outdoor play area shall be:
- (d) Safe from foreseeable hazard;
- (e) Well drained;
- (f) Well maintained;
- (g) In good repair; and
- (h) Visible to staff at all times.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation of the playground, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. A garden hose that was laying on a wooden storage shed located beside of a set of steps. The garden hose was observed to be within reach and accessible to the children; therefore, the playground was not safe from foreseeable hazard.
- 2. Five white metal poles that were stuck in the ground with soda and rusty tin cans placed on top of the poles. The poles were located beside of the building and were observed to have sharp edges underneath the cans; therefore, the metal poles pose a safety hazard to the children.

During interview, staff-in-charge stated that the metal poles were used for a garden and she would remove the poles and the garden hose from the playground as soon as possible.
