Findings: General: Based on observation and interview, a six-month old infant, who wore overall pants, laid on her stomach on the floor. A caregiver grabbed the straps to the overall pants, picked up and raised the infant by the straps approximately three (3) feet from the floor.

922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements. (8) Diapers or clothing shall be: (a) Changed when soiled or wet; (b) Stored in a covered container temporarily; and (c) Washed or disposed of at least once a day.	
Findings: General: Based on interview, two (2) children's diapers were not immediately changed after being soiled. Interview determined one of the children's diaper was changed approximately fifty (50) minutes after being soiled.

General: Based on observation of the center's recorded video, a caregiver bottle fed an infant, who reclined in a bouncy seat, in the infants' room. The infant was not held.

Findings:

General: Based on observation of the center's recorded video, interview and review of documentation, the center failed to assure each adult, including parents and guardians, at drop-off and pick-up, wore a face mask while inside a child care center, in accordance with 922 KAR 2:405E Section 8(1). A caregiver wore a face mask below her nose and mouth while in the infants' room.
