General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the Fire Marshall report to be dated 1/24/18. Upon interview, staff stated that they should have a more recent report. Staff contacted central office but was unable to provide a current Fire Marshall Report for the surveyor to review during the visit; therefore, the child-care center failed to provide documentation that they are in compliance.

(3) For a child-care center licensed for infant, toddler, or preschool-age children, at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children shall be currently certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in the following skills:

- (a) Infant and child cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and
- (b) Infant and child first aid.
- (4) For a child-care center licensed for school-age children, at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children shall be currently certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in the following skills:
- (a) Adult cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and
- (b) First aid.
- (5) Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and first aid training shall be in addition to the fifteen (15) clock hours requirement in subsection (16) of this section.

### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that none of the center staff possessed current certification in CPR/First Aid. During interview, staff stated that she was aware of this and that the training has been scheduled. The center failed to ensure at least one (1) person was on duty and present with cabinet approved infant/child CPR/First Aid training.
