- (1) A person who is a child care staff member prior to January 1, 2018, shall submit to and complete background checks in accordance with this administrative regulation no later than September 30, 2018.
- (2) A child care staff member hired on or after April 1, 2018, shall:
- (a) Have completed the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation and been found to have no disqualifying offense prior to becoming a child care staff member; or
- (b)1. Have submitted to the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation;
- 2. Not be left unsupervised with a child in care pending the completion of the background checks in accordance with this administrative regulation: and
- 3. Be dismissed or relocated from the residence if the person is found to have a disqualifying background check result.

Findings:

General: Based on review of the KARES system and review of documentation in the staff's file, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. A staff's (DOH: 04/04/21) file did not contain documentation of background checks submitted through the Kentucky National Background Check Service. During interview, staff-incharge confirmed that a background check was not submitted through the Kentucky National Background Check Service and that she stated that she was told she did not have to have a completed background check through the Kentucky National Background Check Service. The staff's file contained a completed Child Abuse/Neglect Background Check dated 04/08/21 and a completed Criminal Records Background Check dated 03/17/21.
- 2. A staff's (DOH: 02/16/21) file did not contain documentation of background checks submitted through the Kentucky National Background Check Service. During interview, staff-incharge confirmed that a background check was not submitted through the Kentucky National Background Check Service. The staff's file contained a completed Child Abuse/Neglect Background Check dated 01/05/21 and a completed Criminal Records Background Check dated 01/10/21.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor could not locate a current Fire Marshall Report. The staff-in-charge could not provide the surveyor with a copy of a current report. During interview, the staff stated that the Fire Marsal had recently been to the center for an inspection; however, the staff contacted their central office but was unable to provide a current Fire Marshall Report to review during the visit.

General: Based on review of documentation, one (1) staff's (DOH: 03/12/1997) file did not contain documentation of a current TB skin test or a statement from a health professional stating that the individual was free from active tuberculosis.

Findings:

General: Based on observation of the classroom, the surveyor found an unlocked cabinet located below the sink that contained the following: one (1) bottle of Dawn Dish Liquid Soap, one (1) container of Clorox Disinfecting Wipes, three (3) containers of Wipes Plus Disinfecting Wipes, one (1) bottle of Array Citrus Spray & Wipe, one (1) can of Array Disinfectant Deodorizer and one (1) can of Array Glass Cleaner.

The items mentioned each contained a label that stated, "Keep Out of Reach of Children." The items were observed to be accessible and within reach of the children.

Findings:

General: Based on observation in the children's restroom, the surveyor found that there was a tear in one (1) diaper changing pad; therefore, the diaper changing surface was not free of holes, rips, tears, or other damage.

General: Based on observation of the playground, the surveyor found that several overgrown tree limbs were protruding through the fence located on the right side of the playground and the back left corner of the playground. Therefore, the playground area was not well maintained.

- (21) A protective surface shall:
- (a) Be provided for outdoor play equipment used to:
- 1. Climb;
- 2. Swing; and
- 3. Slide; and
- (b) Have a fall zone equal to the height of the equipment.

Findings:

General: Based on observation on the outdoor playground, the surveyor found that the woodchips were depleted throughout the play area and the black liner was showing around the climbing structure; therefore, the protective surface for the climbing structure was not in compliance.
