General: Based on Review of Documentation, staff person hired 11/6/2017 did not have documentation of negative T.B. results on file in the facility that had been obtained within the past two (2) years.

## 922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

#### Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was determined in five (5) of the staff files presented for review that the employees did not have fifteen (15) hours of annual training on file for the last full year of employment. A review of ECE-TRIS records supports the information found during the survey. It was determined in four (4) of the staff files presented for review that the employees did not have evidence of completing the Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training within the first year of employment. General: Based on Observation, a ceiling tile in the School Age room had a brown ring type stain that looked, upon observation, like a water stain. The brown stain covered a large area (approximately one quarter (1/4) to one half (1/2) of the tile.
