Findings:

General: Based on observation, it was found that the toilet paper was not being stored in a proper manner throughout the facility. Some of the toilet paper was on top of the toilet paper holders, but none of the toilet paper was actually on the roll. Storing toilet paper in this way is not sanitary.

- (1) A child-care center shall maintain:
- (e) A current personnel file for each child-care center staff person to include:
- 1. Name, address, date of birth, and date of employment;
- 2. Proof of educational qualifications;
- 3. Record of annual performance evaluation;
- 4. Documentation of compliance with tuberculosis screening in accordance with Section 11(1)(b) of this administrative regulation; and
- 5. The results of background checks conducted in accordance with 922 KAR 2:280;

General: Based on review of documentation, it was found that two staff members did not have evidence of an annual evaluation on file at the facility.

410 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½)

hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the following was found:

- 1.) One staff member did not complete orientation training within the required timeframe.
- 2.) One staff member did not complete the required fifteen-hours of training.

A review of ECE-TRIS confirmed these findings.

- (b) Matches, cigarettes, lighters, and flammable liquids; and
- (c) Personal belongings and medications of staff.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1.) There was an unlocked closet in the preschool that contained florscent lightbulbs, tiles, and other various items.
- 2.) There was a bottle of disinfectant spray and a roll of trash bags in an unlocked drawer of the handwashing sink in the toddler room.
- There was a broom and dust pan accessible to the children in the toddler classroom.
- 4.) There was a toilet brush being stored in a plastic bag on the back of the door knob in the back bathroom of the preschool room.
- 5.) There was a roll of trash bags being stored in a plastic bin at the front of the preschool classroom.
- All of these items were accessible to the children.

580 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1.) There was mismatched paint on the wall in the infant room. It was stated by the staff in charge that this area was used as a dry erase area.
- 2.) There were holes in the wall of the front bathroom in the preschool classroom. It appeared to be holes from where a paper towel rack used to be hung.
- 3.) There were stained ceiling tiles, as well as a sagging tile that was coming away from the ceiling itself. This was located in the front bathroom of the preschool room.
- 4.) There were three stained ceiling tiles in the preschool room.
- 5.) There were stained ceiling tiles in the bathroom of the classroom that was being used by the school-age children on the date of the survey.
- 6.) There were two stained ceiling tiles in the classroom that was being used by the school-age children on the date of this survey.

640 - Toilet Room **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (2) A toilet room shall:
- (a) 1. Be provided for each gender; or
- 2. A plan shall be implemented to use the same toilet room at separate times;
- (b) Have a supply of toilet paper; and
- (c) Be cleaned and disinfected daily.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, it was found that there were no paper towels in the bathroom of the school-age building.

General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1.) There was a chirping fire alarm indicating a low battery in the school-age building.
- 2.) The seats in the van used for transportining children were torn in some areas, leaving the foam on the insides exposed.
 3.) There was an old intercom system in the school-age building. One of the speakers for this system was coming out of the wall. It was originally being secured in the wall by orange duct tape. There were no wires exposed.
