General: Based on review of documentation, staff member hired on 12/30/2020, did not have written documentation of a child abuse and neglect check on file. The staff member was working alone in the three-year-old classroom at the time of the inspection.

- 1) There was a small clear plastic bag of nails found in an unlocked sink cabinet drawer in the toddler classroom. The nails were accessible to the children.
- 2) The smoke detector was beeping in the Pre-K room and in the School-Age building.

General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1) An infant was found in a crib propped up on a boppy pillow. Staff in the classroom stated that the child did not have a doctor's note requesting she use the boppy pillow.
- 2) A second infant was found asleep in a crib with a bib secured around the child's neck.

General: Based on observation, there were containers of bleach found on a low table near the door leading out to the playground. The bleach was accessible to the children.
