Based on review of documentation, there was no documentation made available at the time of survey regarding a Fire Marshal report.

### 922 KAR 2:090. Section 8. General.

- (1) A licensee shall:
- (a) Be responsible for the operation of the child-care center pursuant to this administrative regulation, 922 KAR 2:120, and 922 KAR 2:280; and
- (b) Protect and assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1.) There were two sets of stacked chairs placed on top of a table in the One-Year-Old classroom. Children were playing and walking around the table with the stacked chairs. Storing chairs in this manner is a safety hazard to the children in care.
- 2.) There was an uncovered, broken electrical outlet with sharp edges in the hallway leading to the classrooms.

#### 922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
- (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, one staff hired on 8/12/19, did not complete Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma Training within the first year of employment. A review of ECE-TRIS confirmed this finding.

- (3) Rest time shall occur in an adequate space according to the child's age as follows:
- (a) For an infant:
- 3. No bedding other than a clean tight-fitted sheet; and
- 4. No toys or other items except the infant's pacifier;

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, an infant was asleep in a crib with a boppy pillow and a blanket. There should be nothing in a crib with an infant other than a clean tight-fitted sheet; and no toys or other items except the infant's pacifier.

- (a) Have an indicating thermometer or other appropriate temperature measuring device;
- (b) Be in a safe environment for preservation; and
- (c) Be forty (40) degrees Fahrenheit or below.

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, the refrigerator used to store milk did not have an indicating thermometer; therefore, the temperature of the refrigerator could not be determined.
