Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, observation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee's records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Upon request the child care director did not present verification that the out of state background check had been completed for the employees with the hire dates of 01/24/2017 and 10/03/2016. The employee with the hire date of 01/24/2017 had resided in the state of Indiana and the employee with the hire date of 10/03/2016 had resided in Tennessee and Oklahoma within the last five (5) years. The employees were not observed working alone.

Observation of the one-year-old classroom from 08:35 a.m. a.m. to 11:45 a.m. revealed there were six (6) children present. Measurement of the classroom revealed the room measured for five (5) children; therefore not allowing a minimum of thirty-five (35) square feet of space per child.
