(1) An infant shall sleep or nap on the infant's back unless the infant's health professional signs a waiver that states the infant requires an alternate sleeping position.

Findings:

General: Based on interview, review of documentation, and observation in the infant classroom, a five-month-old infant was sleeping in the crib on top of a "bobby pillow"; therefore, not allowing the infant to sleep or nap on their back. Upon request, the staff did not provide verification that a waiver had been obtained from a physician allowing an alternative sleep position.

922 KAR 2:410E. Emergency Regulation.

Due to the current declared public health emergency caused by the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), licensed child care centers must operate under Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and public health guidelines, as mandated by 922 KAR 2:410E, to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the center failed to comply with the regulatory requirements specific to the current pandemic as established in 922 KAR 2:410e. Two (2) employees in the infant classroom were observed not wearing a mask properly. The nose region was exposed.
