General: Based on observation of a floor vent located in the infant classroom, the surveyor observed there to be dirt and debris on the filter. An infant crawling on the floor could potentially stick their finger in the vent openings; therefore, having access to the dirt and debris on the filter. In an interview with the director, the surveyor was informed that recent work had been done in the infant classroom and the filter has not yet been changed.
