922 KAR 2:090. Section 10. Director Requirements and Responsibilities.

(1) A director shall:

(e) Manage the staff in their individual job descriptions;

(f) Assure the development, implementation, and monitoring of child-care center plans, policies, and procedures;

(g) Supervise staff conduct to ensure implementation of program policies and procedures;

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, the child care center director failed to assure that the child care center staff follow the center's policy handbook. The following was found:

1. A staff person did not follow the center's cell phone policy when the staff used her personal cell phone in a classroom to video tape a child and another staff person. The center's cell phone policy states, "Cell phone are not permitted in any of the program rooms." The center policy also states, "Cell phone use is permitted only during an approved break, and never in a classroom."

2. A staff person did not follow the center's video policy when the staff person used a video of a child in care of the center and posted the video on her personal Facebook page. The center's video policy states that videos can only be used for the following, "Give videos to current parents" or "YouTube promotional videos."
