1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or

2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that one (1) staff (DOH: 11/3/14) file contained a copy of a tuberculin skin test result that was no longer current as of 3/24/17.

(14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following: (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;

(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

General: Based on review of documentation and ECE - TRIS, the surveyor found the following:

(1.) Staff (DOH: 11/3/14) obtained five (5) of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet - approved early care and education training.

(2.) Staff (DOH: 8/18/11) obtained one (1) of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet - approved early care and education training.

(3.) Staff (DOH: 9/2/10) obtained two (2) of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet - approved early care and education training.

(4.) Staff (DOH: 10/22/10) obtained five (5) of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet - approved early care and education training.
