Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor was presented with the following:

- 1. Staff's (DOH: 03/01/2002) file contained a copy of a negative tuberculin result dated 08/08/2019. During interview, staff confirmed the staff did not have an updated copy of a negative tuberculin result or a statement from a health professional indicating that the staff is free of active tuberculosis; therefore, the surveyor was unable to verify if the staff member was free from active tuberculosis.
- 2. Staff's (DOH: 08/01/2018) file contained a copy of a negative tuberculin result dated 03/21/2019. During interview, staff confirmed the staff did not have an updated copy of a negative tuberculin result or a statement from a health professional indicating that the staff is free of active tuberculosis; therefore, the surveyor was unable to verify if the staff member was free from active tuberculosis.
- 3. Staff's (DOH: 09/01/2018) file contained a copy of a negative tuberculin result dated for 03/21/2019. During interview, staff confirmed the staff did not have an updated copy of a negative tuberculin result or a statement from a health professional indicating that the staff is free of active tuberculosis; therefore, the surveyor was unable to verify if the staff member was free from active tuberculosis.
- 4. Staff's (DOH: 12/01/2016) file contained a copy of a negative tuberculin results dated for 01/11/2019. During interview, staff confirmed the staff did not have an updated copy of a negative tuberculin result or a statement from a health professional indicating that the staff is free of active tuberculosis; therefore, the surveyor was unable to verify if the staff member was free from active tuberculosis.
- 5. Staff's (DOH: 11/15/2019) file contained a copy of a negative tuberculin result dated for 08/08/2019. During interview, staff confirmed the staff did not have an updated copy of a negative tuberculin result or a statement from a health professional indicating that the staff is free of active tuberculosis; therefore, the surveyor was unable to verify if the staff member was free from active tuberculosis.

Staff-in-charge reported she has tried to schedule the staff's tuberculosis test. Staff-in-charge stated the staff's tuberculosis test will be completed as soon as possible.

435 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
- (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. A staff's (DOH: 11/15/2019) file and ECE-TRIS did not contain verification that the staff had completed the six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation training, the one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training, or the fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training.
- 2. A staff's (12/01/2016) file did not contain verification that the staff had completed the fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training. A review of ECETRIS revealed that the staff obtained one (1) of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training.
- 3. A staff's (03/01/2002) file did not contain verification that the staff had completed the fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training. A review of ECE-TRIS revealed that the staff obtained zero (0) of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training.
- 4. A staff's (09/01/2018) file did not contain verification that the staff had completed the fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training. A review of ECE-TRIS revealed that the staff obtained zero (0) of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training.
- 5. A staff member's file (10/15/2018) file did not contain verification that the staff had completed the fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training. A review of ECE-TRIS revealed that the staff obtained zero (0) of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training.

According to the staff-in-charge, the staff's training was not completed between the timeframe of 7/1/2020 through 6/30/2021 due to a lack of funds and the child care center being closed for COVID 19.
