Upon request, the director did not present a current fire marshal report at the time of the survey.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center director failed to assure compliance with regulatory requirements. Review of the presented employee records revealed nine (9) staff members with hire dates 6/6/17, 8/8/17, 8/19/16, 5/27/16, 5/27/14, 12/2/13, 8/28/14, 5/22/13 and 5/31/11 whose file did not contain a current written evaluation. Upon request, the director did not present a current evaluation for the aforementioned staff members at the time of the survey.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of the presented employee records revealed a staff member with hire date 11/28/17 whose file did not contain a high school diploma, GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity. Upon request, the director did not present educational documentation for the aforementioned staff member at the time of the survey.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of the presented employee records revealed there was not a person on duty and present with the children in care that was currently certified in Infant/Child nor Adult First Aid on 10/17/18 from 11:00am-2:00pm. Interview with the instructor from BLS revealed that she only conducted CPR training for the staff members on duty at the time of the survey. Upon request, the director did not present documentation to verify current First Aid certification for the staff members on duty at the time of the survey.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Review of the presented employee records revealed a staff member with hire date 11/28/17 whose file did not contain documentation to verify completion of the six (6) hours of cabinet approved orientation training. Continued review of the presented employee records revealed a staff member with hire date 5/31/11 whose file did not contain documentation to verify completion of the one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training. Upon request, the director did not present the training documentation for the aforementioned staff members at the time of the survey.

580 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. There were two (2) water stains located in the ceiling tiles above the wooden cabinet in the Transition Room. There were two (2) large water stains located in two (2) ceiling tiles above the viewing window in the One's Room. There were holes in the ceiling tile located by the fluorescent light bulbs in the bathroom in the One's Room. There was missing paint exposing the drywall located under the viewing window in the Two's Room.

645 - Sink Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (3) A sink shall be:
- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. The sink located in the bathroom in the One's Room was not equipped with a hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material. The sink located in the bathroom in the Preschool Room was not equipped with a hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material.

The two (2) red vinyl-climbing blocks and the one (1) orange vinyl-climbing block located in the Transition Room were torn, exposing the absorbent material. The green, yellow, red and blue pillows located in the reading area in the Preschool Room were dirty/soiled. The half (1/2) door leading into the bathroom in the Preschool Room was broken/not secure. One of the blue cots located in the Preschool Room were torn
