General: Based on interview, it was found that children who do not go to sleep during nap-time are required to lay quietly on their mats for the duration of the nap-time which is from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. Staff indicated that children who do not go to sleep are not provided with a quiet activity while the other children nap.
