As discussed, please store children's nap materials in a way that they do not come into contact with one another. Infant ratios allow for 6 children under the age of 2 years of age, not 18 months as other infant regulations direct. Unless an immunization record can be provided for E.S., care may not be provided as the regulations do not accept religious exemptions. There is a process to allow care if the parent chooses to start immunizing. Please contact me if this is desired. If not, it is acceptable to give a two week notice to allow other care arrangements.
