(2) The department must be given access to all records and an opportunity to copy the records whenever children are in care.

The intent of this rule was not met:

Based on interview, CCL found that caregiver files were not available for review by the Department at the time of inspection. It was found that the records were locked and could not be accessed by any employee on site.

(11) Providers must develop a written policy that describes the practices to be used to promote a safe sleep environment when children under age two are napping or sleeping.

The intent of this rule was not met:

Based on interview, CCL found the provider did not have a written policy describing practices used to promote a safe sleep environment available for review.

This plan of correction was accepted on May 18, 2017.

(12) All caregivers shall sign an acknowledgement indicating that they have read and understood the provider's policy outlined in (11).

The intent of this rule was not met:

Based on interview, CCL found that there was no safe sleep policy signed by all caregivers.
