Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.32(7) requires that children be supervised at all times and that the persons supervising in the child care area be alert, able to respond promptly to the needs and actions of the children being supervised, as well as the actions of the chaperones and Students-in-Training, and provide timely attention to the children's actions and needs. It was determined based on the consultant's investigative findings that on December 18, 2019, a seventeen-month-old child was able reach a neighboring child's plate during breakfast time and eat a French toast stick containing egg and egg was a known allergen to the child. Adequate supervision and watchful oversight were not maintained in order to prevent the incident from occurring.
