If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgement on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Finding

591-1-1-.26(7) requires that climbing and swinging equipment be anchored and have a resilient surface beneath the equipment. The fall-zone from such equipment must be adequately maintained by the Center to assure continuing resiliency. It was determined, based on an observation that there was less than two inches of resilient surface beneath the tube slide and the climbing structure on the front right side of the play equipment. It was further determined, that there was less than one inch of resilient surface around the fall zones beneath the swings.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure that climbing and swinging equipment is anchored. The Center will develop and/or follow a plan for routine inspections of the resilient surface and for replacing when needed.
