If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. It was determined based on observation that a potential hazard existed in that a rusted pink tricycle was observed in the outdoor play area.

To ensure the health and safety of children, the Home Provider will remove the rust from the trycycle or remove the tricycle from the outdoor play area.
