If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Finding

591-1-1-.12(2)(a) requires that equipment and furniture be free from hazardous conditions such as, but not limited to, sharp rough edges or toxic paint. It was determined based on consultant's observation a red sink bucket in the home living area of classroom H-3R was observed to be broken on the back middle left side of the classroom. It was further determined based on consultant's observation a red sofa chair in classroom E-2L was observed to be torn with exposed foam located in the back right side of the cozy area and the black handle on the stove located in classroom I-2R was observed to be loose and not securely attached to the stove door on the back right side of the home living area.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center director will develop/implement a system for informing center staff about identification of hazards and what to do when a hazard is identified.

It was determined based on consultant's observation of classroom D-1L three children were observed to have their pacifiers attached to their clothing on this date.

Consultant observed four of 22 staff members to have a satisfactory local criminal records check on file. A one-day letter was left on this date.
