# Finding

591-1-1-.08(a)-(f) requires Center Staff to maintain a file for each child while such child is in care and for one year after that child is no longer enrolled that includes the following information: (a) child's name, birth date, sex, address, living arrangement, name of school if applicable; (b) names of both Parents, home and work addresses, and home and work telephone numbers; (c) name(s) and addresses of the person(s) to whom the child may be released including address, telephone number, relationship to child and other identifying information; (d) name(s) and telephone number(s) of person(s) to contact in emergencies when the Parent cannot be reached; (e) name and telephone number of the child's primary source of health care; and (f) known allergies, physical problems, mental health disorders, mental retardation or developmental disabilities which limit the child's participation in the program. It was determined based on a review of records that 2 of 5 children's files did not have the address documented for the person's authorized to pick up the children.
