Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.03(3)(e) requires center staff to refrain from engaging in, or allowing children or other adults to engage in, activities that could be detrimental to a child's health or well-being, such as but not limited to, horse play, rough play, wrestling, and picking up a child in a manner that could cause injury. It was determined based on investigative findings, the teacher allowed a two-year-old to jump up and down on a blue chair in the living area of the classroom, which resulted in the child sustaining a serious injury to her left arm.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will review requirements with staff to ensure that appropriate activities are conducted with children.

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.07(2) requires Center Staff to immediately notify Parents and obtain specific instructions until the child can be picked up or returned to the group when professional medical attention is required, or when the child experiences symptoms of moderate discomfort such as elevated temperature, vomiting or diarrhea and to notify Parents by the end of the day when professional medical attention is not required, when the child experiences symptoms of less than moderate discomfort or when the child experiences an adverse reaction to prescribed medication which does not constitute moderate discomfort. It was determined based on investigative findings, the center failed to notify the parents that a two-year-old child injured her arm while in care and complained about being pain throughout the day.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will provide notification.

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.17(2) requires that Personnel, to the extent possible, keep children clean, dry and comfortable. It was determined based on investigative findings, that the center failed to comfort a two-year-old child that complained of being in pain throughout the day.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure that staff are responsive to children's needs to be clean, dry and comfortable, the center will ensure each child in care is clean, dry, and comfortable at all times.
