This Monitoring Visit is the second regulatory visit for Susie's Daycare this 2016 - 2017 fiscal year.

The consultant reviewed all staff files and finds two staff was hired prior to January 1, 2014, has a preliminary fingerprint on file however no current COGENT on file. A one day letter was left with the center director.

The director has submitted a porfolio to Quality Rated and waiting for her initial visit.

The consultant discussed SIDS / Safe Sleep with the infant staff.

Any rule violation which subjects a child to injury or life-threatening situation or any rule violations previously cited but not corrected, may result in the imposition of an adverse enforcement action. Serious or continued noncompliance may also jeopardize participation in one or more DECAL program(s).

If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. A one-day letter was left with the center director.
