Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Finding

290-2-3-.08(1)(a) requires the Home to maintain a file for each Child that includes the Child's name, birth date, Parent's name, Home and business addresses and telephone numbers. It was determined that the provider did not have this information completed for one of five children enrolled.

The Home Provider will secure the missing information, and to ensure that children's records are completed for future enrollees, the provider will ensure that all required information is included in children's enrollment packets.

Finding

290-2-3-.08(2)(c) requires that the Family Child Care Learning Home's policies and procedures to include written procedures for:

1. guidance and discipline techniques;

- 2. handling emergency care;
- 3. administering medication;

4. notifying Parents of ill or injured Children or exposure to a communicable disease;

- 5. noticeable adverse reaction to medication; 6. exclusion of sick Children;
- 7. exclusion of Children with communicable diseases;
- 8. emergency plans for severe weather, fire and physical plant problems;
- 9. transportation of Children;

10. identification of others providing care;

11. Parents' ability to visit the Family Child Care Learning Home; 12. daily communication practices with Parents;

13. notification of firearms within home;

14. notification of changes in the composition of the home;

15. notification of any pets or animals;

16. notice of infant sleep position practices; 17. documenting the Child's arrival and departure, to include the date, Child's name, arrival and departure times, and signature or initials of Parent, guardian, or authorized person; these sign in/out records shall be made available to the Department upon request. It was determined that the provider's policies and procedures did not include all of the required information in that the safe sleep practices was not included.
