## **Finding Associated with Complaint**

591-1-1-.03(3)(e) requires center staff to refrain from engaging in, or allowing children or other adults to engage in, activities that could be detrimental to a child's health or well-being, such as but not limited to, horse play, rough play, wrestling, and picking up a child in a manner that could cause injury. It was determined based on a compliant investigation, a staff member cut a small amount of a child's hair while removing the beads from the child's hair.
