If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. In order for the Department to issue a satisfactory Fingerprint Records Check Determination, each Employee and Director must submit both a Fingerprint Records Check Application to the Department and Fingerprints to an authorized fingerprinting site. It was determined that four staff members hired prior to January 1, 2014 have not completed the Livescan fingerprint process. Registrations with cogent were observed for all staff members. Satisfactory preliminary checks were on file, however staff were to complete the Livescan process prior to January 1, 2017.
