Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Finding

591-1-1-.33(5) requires ten clock hours of annual training for supervisory and caregiver Staff, except for independent contractors, Students-in-Training and volunteers, in the subjects of early childhood education, child development or subjects related to the position. It was determined based on a review of staff records and staff statements that staff had not received the required ten hours of ongoing training during the 2016 calendar year (or for the 2015-2016 school year). Three of the seven current employees were subject to this requirement and none of the three long-term employees had received the required training. Note: One of the employees had received seven hours of training in the school system, but the trainings were not Bright from the Start approved and could not be accepted for licensing purposes.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will plan and schedule the required 10 hours of ongoing training each year and follow up to ensure the training is completed.
