If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Finding

591-1-1-.25(13) requires that hazardous equipment, materials and supplies be inaccessible to children. It was determined based on consultant's observation that unsafe storage of materials dangerous to children were observed as follows:

- -The storage closet, containing several hazards such as purses, cleaning products and cleaning equipment, was unlocked in Classroom A-1, B-2, D-4, F-6 and L-12
- In Classroom 6 lotion, body spray, staples and a stapler were observed on a low shelf and hazards were accessible to children.
- In Classroom 8 a stapler and hand sanitizer were accessible to children

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure the safe storage of hazardous items, the center will train staff in hazardous materials. Staff will also ensure that all potential hazards are made inaccessible at all times.

591-1-1-.26(7) requires that climbing and swinging equipment be anchored and have a resilient surface beneath the equipment. The fall-zone from such equipment must be adequately maintained by the Center to assure continuing resiliency. It was determined based on measurements, that the resilient surface beneath the tan slide on Playground B measured less that three inches where it should have measured six inches.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure that climbing and swinging equipment is anchored. The Center will develop and/or follow a plan for routine inspections of the resilient surface and for replacing when needed.
