290-2-3-,19(4) requires that if cots and mats are stored in the children's activity room or area, they shall be stored to prevent children's access to them and to allow maximum use of play space. When storage is available and used for the storage of cots and mats that allows the cots, mats and any bedding to be stored without touching any other cots, mats or bedding, the bedding may be left on the cot or mat. When such storage is not available for the cots and mats, each child's bedding shall be kept separate from other children's bedding and stored in containers marked for individual use, such as, but not limited to, bins, cubbies, or bags. It was determined by consultant observation that the bedding for each child was stored in a closet touching.

290-2-3-.08(8) requires the Home to conduct drills for fire monthly and for tornado and other emergency situations every six months. The Home shall maintain documentation in the Home of the dates and times of these drills for two years. It was determined by review of records that the provider did not have evidence of current fire drills. The last fire drill was dated for August 2016.

Hair grease was observed on a shelf in the dining area accessible to the children. Bleach solution was observed on a fax machine in the dining area accessible to the children.
