591-1-1-.12 Equipment & Toys(CR)

Comment

On this date, Consultant observed equipment, furniture and toys throughout the Center, to be non - hazardous, fully - secured, and not able to cause injury from tipping, falling, or being pulled or pushed over.

On this date, the Center Director/Administrator stated that the program will not participate in Swimming/water activities, in water measuring two (2) feet in depth or greater. Further, Consultant observed the bolts to be cut as required and covered to prevent children's access. Consultant also observed the water equipment located on Playground A and Playground B to have all loose rocks removed, and a fully attached, non-removable cover and enclosure on top of the equipment. Additionally, Consultant observed all drainage areas/containers to be removed from the water equipment, to prevent standing water.

Further, Consultant stated to Center Director and Administrator, that prior to providing Transportation, the Center is required to contact the assigned Bright from the Start: Regional Consultant, to discuss and review all Transportation requirements.

Sleeping & Resting Equipment
