591-1-1-.03(9) requires center staff to refrain from engaging in, or allowing children or other adults to engage in, activities that could be detrimental to a child's health or well-being, such as but not limited to, horse play, rough play, wrestling, and picking up a child in a manner that could cause injury. It was determined based on investigative findings that on December 29 2017, a one-year-old child was picked up in a manner which caused injury to the arm and wrist of the child, which resulted in the one-year-old child receiving professional medical attention as a result of the injury.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will review requirements with Staff to ensure that appropriate activities are conducted with children.
