If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Finding

591-1-1-.25(13) requires that hazardous equipment, materials and supplies be inaccessible to children. It was determined based on observation that unsafe storage of materials dangerous to children were observed as follows: a plastic bag of wipes reading "keep out of reach of children" was observed on a table in classroom F, a bottle of OdoBan disinfectant was accessible in a low, unlocked cabinet in the bathroom in classroom A. Additionally a vacuum, broom, and mop were observed in a corner accessible in classroom A.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure the safe storage of hazardous items, the center will ensure cleaning supplies and tools stored out of reach. Also that items labeled "keep out of reach of children" are stored away.
