290-2-3-.13(2)(a) requires that outdoor play areas be kept clean and free of hazards such as exposed sharp corners of concrete or equipment, rust and splinters on equipment, broken glass, open drainage ditches, holes and stagnant water. It was determined based on observations that two small metal pipes were observed protruding from the ground near the brown storage house. In addition five metal poles from the old chain link fence were still in the ground and accessible in the children play area.

**POI (Plan of Improvement)**

To ensure the health and safety of children, the Home Provider will remove the poles or cover with a soft padding. The provider will cover the metal pipes that are above the ground near the storage house.
