If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

It was determined based on consultants observation that unsafe storage of materials dangerous to children were observed as follows in a diaper bag and backpack in the child care area:

- -Johnson and Johnson baby lotion
- -vaseline
- -two bottle of ibuprofen

To ensure the safe storage of hazardous items, the home provider will make these items inaccessible to the children.

Finding

290-2-3-.13(1) requires that the Home be clean and free from hazards. It was determined based on consultant observation that the following areas/items were found to be noncompliant:

- -the brown rug in the main child care area was posing a tripping hazard at the edges.
- -the door frame leading to the outside was chipping paint and had rust exposed.
- -the second right door bottom was broken at the bottom with sharp edges, and a gap posing a potential entrapment hazard.
- -the ceiling in the main child care area was chipping paint.

To ensure the cleanliness and safety of the environment, the Home Provider will make hazardous items inaccessible to the children.
