If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. It was determined based upon consultant's observation, that a staff member in room 201 did not wash hands immediately before a diaper change on this date.

Center Staff will be trained to wash their hands correctly before and after each diaper change and the director or designated person will monitor to ensure correct procedures continue to be used. The Center will institute and follow procedures that ensure Staff responsible for diaper changing are not simultaneously assigned to kitchen food preparation duties.
